

Are You Ready?



In some emergencies, you may be asked to evacuate. In such cases, you'll want an easy-to-carry container, like a backpack, duffle bag, or trash can, with adequate emergency supplies. Emergency Preparedness Kits should be considered for your home, car, and office to provide food, water, and medical supplies for 3-5 days of being isolated. It's a good idea to keep some cash in your emergency kit. Store the kit in a convenient location. Also, be sure that everyone in the family has a list of important phone numbers and that you've decided on two alternative places to meet in case you become separated. If you have pets, prepare for their needs too.
