Per our discussion I am forwarding the response from Bace Geotechnical regarding TSRA recommendations for the remedial work of the five (5) areas of bluff top failure and Michael Lane's analysis letter of the original reports and the response from Regional Parks. Please share this new information with TSRA members.

I also wanted to discuss the topics for the April 14, 2007 TSRA member meeting. We are now at the point where our collaborative group has identified several alternatives for addressing the loss of the public access easement on the Bluff Top Trail and Walk On Beach. These alternatives will provide the basis for evaluating the environmental impacts associated with implementation of the remedial work to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

It would seem that the best approach for the April 14, 2007 member meeting would be to reiterate the alternatives for each of the sites, review each alternative in respect to the Bluff Erosion Principles developed by TSRA in October 2005, and discuss the CEQA process and a tentative schedule for completion of the environmental component of the project.

It is important that TSRA members be aware that this may be the last meeting prior to public notification and involvement during the CEQA process.
