Fire Season

Our rural environment with natural vegetation is vulnerable to wildfires. Dry forest and grasslands are an extreme wildfire hazard. Fire Danger signs are installed and updated to promote fire safety awareness. These signs are updated by our Security Patrol Officers, with the assessment from CAL FIRE, which is based upon a number of factors such as weather and fuel moisture.

Location of Fire Danger Signs:

- Southbound Hwy 1: north of Halcyon, west side
- Annapolis Road: The Sea Ranch Fire Station
- Northbound Hwy 1: South of Lodge, east side

Remember in order to protect our lives, homes and environment, be especially vigilant at all times.

- NO Smoking Smoking is prohibited year 'round on all trails, common areas and restricted common areas of The Sea Ranch.
- NO Fireworks
- NO Open Fires
- Be cautious when barbequing
- Properly dispose of ashes in ash cans

Always know your potential evacuation route, and how to get to Highway One, preferably two different ways.

Always report any fires or accidents immediately to 911.
