

## **EMERGENCY: Who Do You Call?**

### **FOR ALL EMERGENCIES - DIAL 911**

Emergency calls must be directed to 911, not to security. Sea Ranch Security is NOT an emergency service provider. The primary role of our Security officers is to observe and report TSRA CC&R and Rule violations, and to delegate problems to appropriate agencies. Security officers also assist the agencies within the scope of their training.

If a fire, medical, or law enforcement problem presents itself, even if it seems minor, only a public safety agency has jurisdiction. Fires (no matter how small), medical emergencies, lost or missing persons, traffic accidents, and suspected crimes in progress should be reported to 911.

If your residence land line is out and you have no cell phone:

Go directly to one of the six emergency call boxes located on Highway One (mile markers 58.30 – 56.25 – 52.29 – 54.41 – 53.96 – 50.83) where your call will be transmitted directly to an emergency operator. We know that nothing can replace the ability to call 911 from your home telephone; however, when your home phone does not work, an emergency call box will get emergency help on the way.
